

St. Margaret School Uniforms for 2022-23 Frequently Asked Questions

1-Are all students required to wear uniforms? The uniform policy is mandatory for all students from Pre k -8th grade. (see regulations on website)

2-What is the uniform for Pre k students? All pre k students are required to wear SMS gym uniforms (sweatpants or navy leggings) and/or Spirit Wear clothing. We encourage PK to wear sneakers on a daily basis (any color)

3-May the girls wear leggings? **Yes**, the students may wear **navy blue** leggings. Only Navy Blue, White or Black socks can be worn .

4-Can the Spirit Wear gear be worn every day? **No**, Spirit Wear cannot be worn every day. *Spirit Wear (Blue, White or Gray) can be worn on designated gym days - Spirit Wear are clothing and accessories with our logo to promote SMS. . An order form for SMS Spirtwear will come out in Sept and Dec. Spirit Wear make great gifts for Christmas, Birthday, etc.*

5-Can students wear hooded sweatshirts during school time? Hoodies can be worn to and from school and at recess but **not during class time or in gym class.**

6-Can sneakers be worn with the winter uniform? YES

7-Are the girls in middle school permitted to wear winter kilts as their summer uniform? **Yes**, the girls are permitted to wear the winter kilts as their summer uniform.

8-What is the acceptable length of the school winter uniform for the girls? All uniforms are expected to be no shorter than three inches above the knee.

9-What types of shoes are acceptable for the winter uniforms? Athletic Sneakers (Blue, White or Black) for Boys and Girls, Merrills Slip on Shoe, Sperry's or Bucks

These shoes can be purchased at any department store, Flocco, or Flynn & O'Hara.

10-Can students wear nail polish? Students can wear clear or a reasonable color nail polish only.

11- Are students allowed to color their hair? (example: purple, red, blue etc.)
No hair color is acceptable

12: Can boys wear their hair long?
Boys hair should be clean cut and not below the neck.

13- Do students have to wear a MASK? No, not at this time.
